Principal's Message

Thank you to those who have returned their Resource Scheme forms for 2019. I will be arranging a short meeting/discussion with each family in week 9 and 10 to confirm all information for 2019.

**Finances will close at the end of business 11th December, 2018. All payments after this date can be paid by cash with a manual receipt, then an official receipt will be issued next year. This will ensure all reconciles can be completed as required by the dept.**

At this stage we are looking like we may have a 4<sup>th</sup> class in 2019. This depends on our numbers on Day 8 (7<sup>th</sup> February) 2019. If we stay with 3 classes the likely classes will be a P-1-2, Yr 2-3-4, Yr 5-6. If we go to 4 classes, the likely classes will be a P-1-2, Yr 2-3, Yr 3-4-5, Yr 5-6.

These are only likely classes at the moment. I will inform you of certainty as soon as I know it.
