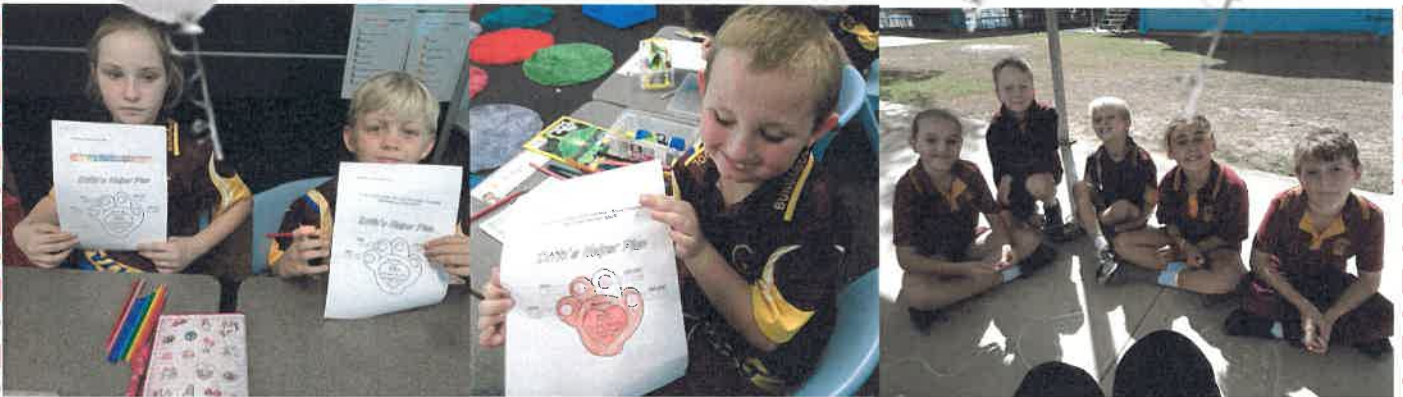

## 5-6 Science



Students in Yr 5-6 were given a **Stem challenge**—Build a structure from uncooked long noodles and marshmallows. This structure had to be strong enough to withstand an



“earthquake” (simulated by placing it on a wobbly chair and moving it to the extreme). Students working in a group decided to make triangle shapes from the noodles, (cut smaller) and then joined them with the marshmallows.
