Writing

Improve writing performance Prep- Year 6. Build teacher capacity and enhance teacher knowledge of writing across learning areas and subjects of the Australian Curriculum Writing. Writing Coach to work collaboratively with teachers. Target: 85% students achieving A-C in Writing.

Reading and Numeracy

Increase the reading level of Prep – Year 3 students to indicated benchmark levels and above.

Increase the percentage of Year 3 and Year 5 students attaining the National Minimum Standard in Literacy and Numeracy to 100% in 2019 NAPLAN.

Increase the spelling level of Prep – Year 6 students to at benchmark or above, in 2019 NAPLAN.

Participate in Pre and Post Moderation of English and Mathematics Diagnostic Assessment with all teachers, Principal Advisor – Teaching and Learning and Early Years Coach.

Age appropriate pedagogies

Participate in Connecting the Dots – Age Appropriate Pedagogies through collaboration with all teachers and the AAP Coach.

Our initiatives include

Continuing to embed Daily Rapid Reading into the Prep to Year 3 classes with (some students are above this year level yet still below benchmark).


Further embedding the LEM Phonics for Spelling into all year levels.

Developing teacher understanding and commitments to developing writing stamina with reference to the general capabilities through Writing Coach specialist. Improving NAPLAN data.


Work collaboratively with Early Years Coach to embed the Age Appropriate Pedagogies in all classrooms particularly Prep -1 in 2019.
